If you are applying from abroad, you will receive instructions on how to apply for a student visa (F-1) at the US consulate and information about your arrival in the US. If you are currently in the US, our international student advisor is available to answer any questions and/or concerns you may have about changing your immigration status to student (F1) or about transferring your SEVIS record to High Expectations. All new F-1 visa applicants are required by the Department of Homeland Security to pay a one-time SEVIS fee of \$350 directly to immigration via the internet or mail.

### TUITION AND FEES

After the 20th of the month, tuition shall be automatically debited in full, from your or your sponsor's bank or credit card account on file and will accrue a \$50 late fee. Returned checks will incur a \$35 returned check fee.

- Students with an open balance for 60 days will be automatically withdrawn from the school for failure to enroll.
